NHS dental charges from 1 April 2011

Band 1 course of treatment – £17.00

This covers an examination, diagnosis (e.g. X-rays), advice on how to prevent future problems, a scale and polish if needed.

Band 2 course of treatment – £47.00

This covers everything listed in Band 1 above, plus any further treatment such as fillings, or if your dentist needs to take out one or more of your teeth.

Band 3 course of treatment – £204.00

This covers everything listed in Bands 1 and 2 above, plus any treatments that may require a laboratory such as crowns and dentures.

Who is entitled to free NHS Dental Care

You do not have to pay for NHS dental treatment if, when the treatment starts, you are:

- aged under 18
- under 19 and receiving full-time education
- pregnant or have had a baby in the previous 12 months
- Claiming Income Support
- Claiming Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Claiming Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Claiming Pension Credit guarantee credit
- Named on a valid NHS tax credit exemption certificate or you are entitled to an NHS tax credit exemption certificate
- Named on a valid HC2 certificate
